## We're making improvements in your area Resurfacing to improve the condition of your road

Dear Resident.

We will shortly be working in your area as part of the Council's 'Pride in Our Community' investment programme. Between 2018 and 2022 we are investing over £50m in creating a better borough with improvements to roads, footpaths, streetlights, road signs, highways structures and green spaces.

In 2020/21 it is the Council's aim to further improve our road network and highway assets. Some £12m will be invested during the next year, delivering 222 improvement schemes across the borough. These improvements will be achieved in partnership with the Council's new highways contractor Balfour Beatty.

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads and footpaths, we will shortly be carrying out resurfacing to improve the condition of the highway on the B5063 between Isombridge Lane and Long Lane.

## When are we planning to deliver this work?

The work is due to take place on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021 and be completed by 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021, weather permitting. These works will be carried out under a road closure (weekdays only between 08:00 – 18:00 (with the exception of Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> where the closure will need to stay on overnight for safety reasons).

We will be working between 08:00 -18:00hrs and will have our dedicated teams on site to assist you during this time to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do so (including the overnight closure on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February). Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption, we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.

## Information about access to your property

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded to allow the surfacing material to harden. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
