NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (General) REGULATIONS 2012 part 2 (5)

APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA: Waters Upton Parish, Telford, Shropshire

Waters Upton Parish Council has completed a series of consultation events and at a Full Council meeting it was unanimously resolved that the Parish Council, as a 'relevant body', wishes to prepare a Neighbourhood Development Plan. I can confirm that Waters Upton Parish Council is a relevant body for the purposes of section 61G of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act.

The defined area for the Waters Upton Plan will be the Parish of Waters Upton, as indicated on the attached map. The Parish Council, on behalf of its community, consider the area to be appropriate for the following reasons:-

- a) The area defined is covered by Waters Upton Parish Council in its entirety
- b) The area was resolved by a unanimous decision of the Parish Councillors after consultation with the communities
- c) The Parish Council leads a steering group of representatives from the Council and Community to oversee the process of producing a Neighbourhood Plan and its future development
- d) It is accepted that Waters Upton Parish, identified as a Key Settlement for growth and development, recognises the important and vital role of the local communities of Great Bolas, Crudgington, Cold Hatton, Waters Upton, Shray Hill, Longwood, Meeson and Sleapford and wish them to have a say in local decision making reflecting future development and retention of our identity.
