A442 Crudgington
Structural patching to improve the condition of your road

Dear Resident,

We will shortly be working in your area as part of the Council's 'Pride in Our Community' investment programme. Between 2018 and 2022 we are investing over £50m in creating a better borough with improvements to roads, footpaths, streetlights, road signs, highways structures and green spaces.

In 2020/21 it is the Council's aim to further improve our road network and highway assets. Some £12m will be invested during the next year, delivering 222 improvement schemes across the borough. These improvements will be achieved in partnership with the Council's new highways contractor Balfour Beatty.

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads and footpaths, we will shortly be carrying out structural patching & joint sealing to improve the condition of the highway on the A442 Crudgington.

When are we planning to deliver this work?

The work is due to take place on 30th November 2020 and be completed by 11th December, weather permitting.

We will be working between 19:00 - 06:00hrs under phased road closures and will have our dedicated teams on site to assist you during this time to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do so. Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption, we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.

The closure is split into two phases;

Phase 1 – (North) Crudgington Crossroads to River Lane, Waters Upton

Phase 2 – (South) Crudgington Crossroads to just south of Sleep Farm

Please be aware that our works are weather sensitive and the order of these phases may change slightly depending on progress and/or weather delays. The planned order of works are as follows;

Monday 30th November – Phase 1
Tuesday 1st December – Phase 1
Wednesday 2nd December – Phase 1
Thursday 3rd December – Phase 2
Friday 4th December – Phase 2

Monday 7th December – Phase 2
Tuesday 8th December – Phase 1
Wednesday 9th December – Contingency for weather delays
Thursday 10th December – Contingency for weather delays
Friday 11th December – Contingency for weather delays

Information about access to your property

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded to allow the surfacing material to harden. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
