**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT  
MODIFICATION ORDER**

**OLD HALL SCHOOL [FOOTPATH 24 (PART)] DIVERSION ORDER  
(PARISH OF WELLINGTON) 2022**

The above Order, made on 14 September 2022, if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by diverting the footpath from a point near the south-east boundary of the College sports field at GR SJ 66111 11497 the route being an undefined path having a width of 1 metre continues north by west across the field for a distance of 225 metres to GR SJ 66100 11721 the continues west for a distance of 225 metres across the field and pitches to GR SJ 65844 11686 just south of the all-weather pitches then continues north by west through the all-weather pitch for a distance of 135 metres to the junction with FP5 at GR SJ 65816 11849 to from a point near the south-east boundary of the College sports field at GR SJ 66111 11497 the route being an undefined path having a width of 2 metres continues north-north-east across the field for a distance of 405 metres to the junction with Footpath 5 at GR SJ 66173 11877. Limitation: Gate at GR SJ 66173 11877

This Order replaces the order previously made on the 28 March 2022 and advertised on 29 April 2022 known as Footpath 24 Diversion Order (Parish of Wellington) 2022.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
