Land Any beneficial interest in land <sup>5</sup> which is within the area of the Council.	NONE

Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the Council for a month or longer.	NONE
Corporate tenancies	
Any tenancy where (to your knowledge)—  (a) the landlord is the Council; and  (b) the tenant is a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest.	NONE

## **NOTES ON SENSITIVE INTERESTS**

An interest is sensitive if you and the Monitoring Officer agree that its disclosure could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation. The nature of your sensitive interest will not appear in the published register of interests but it may be recorded that you have a sensitive interest.

I understand that I must write to the Clerk and Monitoring Officer to tell them about any disclosure of a disclosable pecuniary interest made at a meeting which is not already included above within 28 days of making the disclosure.
